5.	Default dispensing fee – dispensing doctors	SEP + 30% / R41.40 (Excl. VAT) (Government Gazette no.47197 - 5 August 2022)
6.	Default reference pricing	Mediscor Reference Price (MRP)
7.	Payments to providers	Bestmed
8.	Chronic pre-authorisation	Bestmed
